## **Member Criteria To Stand For SOATC Committee**

## Application is subject to certain criteria:

- You must have been a member of the club for at least one full year prior to applying
- The support of a club member to propose your application
- The support of a committee member to second your application

## <u>Committee Member Expectations (in addition to the Club's members expectations):</u>

- The running of the club is the committee's responsibility, the club being run for the benefit of all its members, whether that's pet owners, competitive obedience or agility handlers or, training agility for fun as a committee member you may well be expected to give your time to support an activity that you do not participate in.
- ALL committee members are expected to cover the instruction/supervision
  of training classes as needed, in the case of holidays/illness/other absence
  to ensure the continuity of the business of the club, ensuring insurance and
  council requirements are adhered to
- The organisation of and the running of the club shows is the committee's responsibility, ALL committee members are required to be in attendance to support the set up, running and break down of the shows.
- Due to the demands of organisation, committee members accept that they
   MAY NOT be able to work their own dogs for competition at the shows
- In recognising this commitment the club offers the further incentive of prepaid annual membership to serving committee members and subsidised training at weekly open training sessions
- A minimum time commitment of 150 hours per annum to support club activity
